Terms of Participation

All students receiving funds from the UTSA Mellon Humanities Pathways Fellowship Program agree to the following terms. Failure to abide by these terms will result in the award being revoked and further steps outlined below.

1. Your Department Advisor will be notified of your receipt of this award and will be kept informed about your progress.
2. All recipients of a Mellon Humanities Pathways Fellowship must submit a documented report of all expenditures and fees paid related to travel and project.
3. Mellon Humanities Pathways Fellows are required to submit to the Mexico Center an abstract/report of the research project developed with their program mentor upon completion of their apprenticeship.
4. Mellon Humanities Pathways Fellows are required to present at least once at a UTSA Research conference or another research-focused conference related to the project developed with the program mentor.
5. Mellon Humanities Pathways Fellows are required to participate in ALL program activities as follows:

Period	Activity *	Sessions required
Fall Semester	Informal Seminars	Six sessions (1.5 hrs./per session)
Spring Semester	Apprenticeship	7-10 hrs. per week
Summer	Workshop	Three weeks at UTSA paid by the grant

*Students seeking optional course credit will have to pay tuition and may be required to complete additional academic assignments.

6. Mellon Pathways Fellows are responsible for signing the attendance sheet at each event. Absences are only allowed in case of an emergency, religious observation, or situation that is pre-approved.
7. Fellows are required to complete and submit at least five graduate school applications as part of these program activities.
8. Students should complete UTSA-required travel authorization prior to the initiation of travel.
